January 2nd, 2003. As you may have noticed this is a common Black Eagle, or is it? The Friedberg number is not unusual; the type is of common issue. So, is "The Price Right?" It certainly is! We had this not listed on the website www.GradedCurrency.com for about a month or so and had at least 25 bidders, all of which were gaining ground on the "Buy it Now" price of \$750. Is it the strength of the website and it's viewers??? Here's another example....

An internet auction just closed, item #3301871662, which is a Fr.364 \$5 Treasury Note in CGC-64 (Choice Uncirculated), this note was listed in this very publication for \$1,925 (as of the Dec. '02 issue) and SOLD for \$2,025!!!!!! Now the competitor's price guide shows it at only \$1,350 in ChCu. This particular note sold for over 60% of the competitors price guide or just over 5% of the Gold Sheet's pricing spreadsheet.

Is this note unusual, NO! The Fr.#364 is the most common fr.# there is for the type! Is it a fancy serial number? NO! But, there was a 23 BID history, with the under bidder at \$2,000.99 (just \$24 under), with several others biting hard behind. Then why? And is "The Price Right?" Yes, the price is right, it's a reflection of market value. Why did it sell so strong? We believe after viewing many notes selling on the Internet and on the website (cont. page 12)

Gold sheet article, really research the "return policies." This is key! Many "legitimate" dealers are now allowing buyers to purchase material and allow them to have the notes professionally graded (certified) and if the notes don't hit the grade that they sold them to the buyer at, then the buyer can return the notes.

If a seller (dealer, what have you) is honest and has experience (which most do) then there shouldn't be any reason that they wouldn't feel confident to STAND BEHIND their notes! Period! If the seller tells you that he or she doesn't believe in grading (as you look down at their cases filled with graded/slabbed coins) then you know the reason why! Watch out for these people, they prey on "show" customers, they can sell you an Au note (that goes unnoticed in those crummy show lamps) then fly back to their P.O. Box home and spend the "Superb Gem" money that you just gave them.

In threat of sounding a little cenacle, I have to in good conscious discuss this because after major shows we normally get flooded with submissions, and many times with "show notes" that leave buyers dissatisfied.

"PRICING, GRADING & POPULATION SUMMARY"

This is a "Retail Publication," and is designed to reflect current market prices. These **prices** are procured from many sources, including: Dealers, Internet auctions, previous auction houses "prices realized," striving to reflect current market prices. If the Note Type contains a range of Fr.#'s, then the listed price reflects the most common Fr.#. This publication is in NO way instructing or suggesting for its readers to purchase at these levels. **Grading** ranges from Very Good (MS 8) to Premium Gem (MS 68). The listed prices were gathered from both professionally graded and independently graded "sold" notes. We did denote the observation that prof. graded notes generally sold for higher prices than independently graded notes. A **Population Summary** column is listed for ea. Note Type, many times with a range of Fr.#'s. Example: Fr.#100-102 (1880 \$10 Legal Tender) shows 24-6-38 in the Population column-meaning there are 24 notes in **CU & up** for Fr.#100, 6 notes (in CU & up) for Fr.#101 & 38 notes (in CU & up) for Fr.#102. If you see +++ there are likely more out there than reported.

this type of dishonest behavior by not getting caught up in the "wanting it to be" trap. We recently had a very nice gentlemen submit in a fr.#709 \$1 1918 Boston FRN that he purchased raw as a Superb Gem. He wanted this rare note to be gem so bad for his collection that he believed it was without probably really fully examining the note (almost not wanting to really examine the note). The US Paper Money Population Reports show this note is quite elusive (about 16 total being known) and of those, only 2 ever discovered in Unc. But, he was offered this "GREAT DEAL" by someone who acted like he didn't know what he had and the buyer was the true victim. Again, just request a full receipt and ask the seller (dealer) to write on the receipt the refund policy on it. Good Luck – the notes your wanting are probably out there, just know the perils and intelligently work through them. Have Fun!
